G God created you and has a purpose for you.

Y Your sin is forgiven if you truly accept Jesus' payment.
O You must believe in Jesus and confess Him as Lord & Savior.
U Your turning from sin & turning to God shows you are saved.

To be saved: *Admit* to God you are a sinner and deserve punishment, *ask* Jesus for forgiveness, *accept* Jesus's payment for your sin, *confess* Jesus as your Lord & Savior. Being saved is only the beginning. Now, grow into spiritual maturity by developing a loving, personal relationship with Jesus by regularly praying to Jesus, studying and obeying God's Word (the Bible), trusting Jesus, sharing Jesus with others and fellowshipping with other believers. Once saved, consider being baptized to publicly demonstrate the decision you made for Jesus. Also, the Holy Spirit of God now lives in you to guide, teach, and strengthen you. He is your connection to God. He can help you develop the Fruit of the Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.
